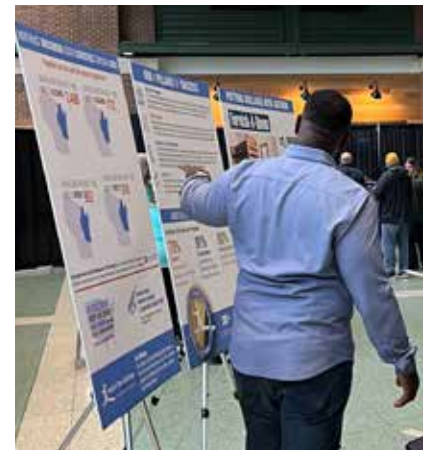
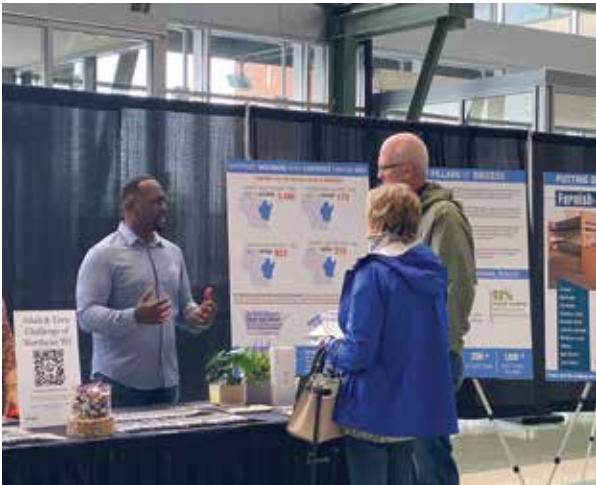


ATCNEW BUILDING RENOVATIONS SOON TO BE COMPLETED

It has been busy here at 999 North Military Ave. since ATCNEW purchased the building on 10/31/2022. Renovations have been underway since February of this year. During the renovations, we took this building formerly used as a commercial office space and turned it into a Men's Residential Treatment Facility that will ultimately house 28 residents. Some of the changes were, creating an administration wing, building a chapel, commercial kitchen, exercise room, media room, and a large communal bathroom with showers, to name a few. Our renovations conclude on August 25th. Then we plan to finish the furnishings and put the final touches on the facility before our Open House.

COMMUNITY IMPACT

On 6/13/23, we were 1 of the non-profits invited to have a presentation table for the Thrivent Financial Investor's Event at Lambeau Field. Through this event, we were able to speak with over 300 families and share the vision and mission of ATCNEW. Being part of this inaugural event was quite an honor, and we look forward to partnering more with Thrivent. On 7/31/23, we held a Festival Foods Brat Barn fundraiser. Our board members and staff had a tremendous time running the event and serving together to raise awareness and support for the launching of our program.

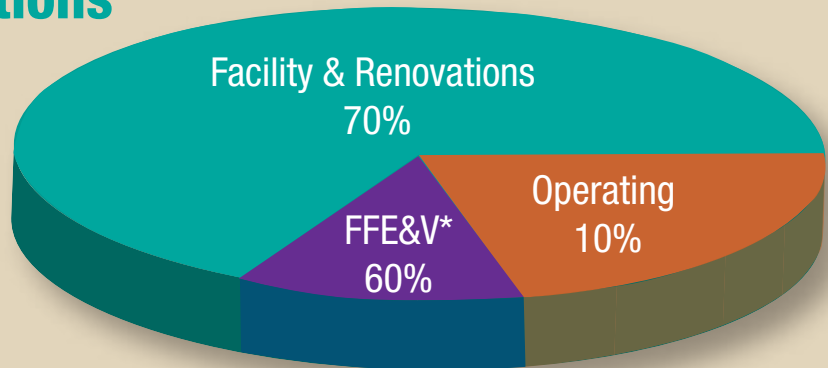
